RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

AGR/WAL, FIN

Establishes the agricultural land acquisition fund to provide funding for the acquisition, administration, maintenance, and management of agricultural lands and irrigation systems to improve food security. Specifies sources of deposits into the fund. Appropriates moneys. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


