<u>HB 1756</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PESTICIDES. Bans import, use, manufacture, sale, and storage of chlorpyrifos in the State.	EEP/AGR, CPC, FIN
<u>HB 2722</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION. Prohibits the application of neonicotinoid insecticides and glyphosate herbicides after December 31, 2020, without a license or permit issued by the State on State public lands under certain conditions.	EEP/AGR, CPC, FIN
<u>HB 2721</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION. Establishes disclosure and public notification requirements for outdoor application of restricted use pesticides in various areas.	EEP/AGR, CPC, FIN
<u>HB 2303</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE PESTICIDE USE REVOLVING FUND. Increase the Pesticide Use Revolving Fund threshold from \$250,000 to \$1,000,000.	EEP/AGR, CPC, FIN
