HB 2011, HD1 (HSCR876-18) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS TAX. Increases the revenue threshold for the tax administration special fund and allocates the additional moneys to the special enforcement section for the enforcement of the transient accommodations tax. (HB2011 HD1)	ETT, WAM
