<u>SB 2722</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION. Establishes the offense of obstructing county real property zoning enforcement operations. Makes the offense a class C felony.	PSM, JDC
<u>SB 2047</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. Requires the Auditor to conduct a performance audit of certain offices and programs within the Department of Public Safety. Appropriates funds.	PSM, WAM
