NANCY PEACOCK, FOR A TERM TO EXPIRE 6-30-2021**

The Department of Land and Natural Resources supports Governor's Message 655, nominating Ms. Nancy Peacock to the Hawaii'i Historic Places Review Board expiring June 30, 2021.

The Hawaii'i Historic Places Review Board (Board) is established under Section 6E-5.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The Board orders and enters historic properties into the Hawaii'i Register of Historic Places and evaluates and recommends nominations to the National Register of Historic Places.

Ms. Peacock's professional activities include Member American Institute of Architects; Licensed Architect (State of Hawaii); Certified Interior Designer (National Council for Interior Design); AIA Hawaii State Council-President (1992); American Society Interior Designers Hawaii Chapter President (2006); past Member Historic Places Review Board; and Advisory Committee-State of Hawaii Regulatory Industries Complaint office.

Ms. Peacock is a Member of Lambda Alpha Honorary Land Economics Society; and Hawaii Opera Theater Board (2009-Present); has previously served as a Member, City and County of Honolulu Department of Land Utilization Design Review Committee (1985-90); Washington Place Foundation Board (2010-13); former President Uluniu Swim Club; Visiting Lecturer at Chaminade University; and Design Juror University of Hawaii Architecture School.
