# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FINANCE TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE FEASIBILITY OF CREATING A PROGRAM THAT WOULD ALLOW QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS TO REMIT VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES ON A BIENNIAL BASIS.

1 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that annual taxes and fees  
2 collected when non-new motor vehicles are registered can have a  
3 dire impact on low-income individuals; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, these low-income individuals may not be able to  
6 pay the taxes and fees in one lump sum or may experience  
7 financial hardship from doing so; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, a possible solution to this issue would be to  
10 allow low-income individuals, or persons deemed to be suffering  
11 a financial hardship, to pay the registration taxes and fees on  
12 a pro-rated biennial basis; now, therefore,  
13

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
15 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of  
16 2019, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Budget and  
17 Finance is requested to conduct a study on the feasibility of  
18 creating a program that would allow qualified individuals to  
19 remit registration fees on a biennial basis; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Budget and  
22 Finance is requested to report the Department's findings and  
23 recommendations to the Legislature no later than twenty days  
24 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2020; and
