Your Committee on Energy & Environmental Protection, to which
was referred H.B. No. 1487 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CLIMATE CHANGE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish a Honolulu
Shoreline Climate Protection Pilot Project to develop a plan to
protect urban Honolulu from the impacts of climate change and be
used as a model for the entire State.

The University of Hawai'i System, The Trust for Public Land,
IMUAlliance, Hawaii Operating Engineers Industry Stabilization
Fund, Sierra Club of Hawai'i, The Nature Conservancy of Hawai'i,
Hawaii Regional Council of Carpenters, Hawaii Bicycling League,
Pacific Resource Partnership, and Surfrider Foundation's Hawaii
Chapters supported this measure. The Department of Land and
Natural Resources and Lei of Parks Coalition offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:


- (1) Changing the appropriation for the development of the
Honolulu Shoreline Climate Protection Pilot Project to
an unspecified amount; and



- (2) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2100, to encourage further discussion on this measure.

No. 1487, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1487, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Finance.
