Your Committees on Lower & Higher Education and Economic Development & Business, to which was referred H.B. No. 624 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE STRUCTURE OF GOVERNMENT,"

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Transfer the rights, powers, functions, and duties of the Hawaii Technology Development Corporation and Hawaii Strategic Development Corporation to the University of Hawaii; and
- (2) Appropriate funds to the University of Hawaii for the succession and implementation of the rights, powers, functions, and duties of the Hawaii Technology Development Corporation and Hawaii Strategic Development Corporation.

The Oceanit Laboratories, Inc. and O'ahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i supported this measure. The University of Hawai'i System and Hawaii Technology Development Corporation provided comments.


