Your Committee on Public Safety, Veterans, & Military
Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 950 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS
SAFETY ACT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish in the Department
of the Attorney General a program responsible for issuing
credentials to qualified retired law enforcement officers who are
state residents to carry concealed firearms pursuant to section
926C(d)(2)(B) of the federal Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act
of 2004 (Public Law 108-277).

The Department of the Attorney General, Department of Public
Safety, Honolulu County Republican Party, and several concerned
individuals supported this measure. The Hawaii Firearms
Coalition, Institute for Rational and Evidence-based Legislation,
and many concerned individuals opposed this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its
effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion on
this measure.
