A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN REPORTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-339, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " ~~[f]§11-339[] Final election period report for candidate~~
4 ~~committee or noncandidate committee] Candidate committees or~~
5 ~~noncandidate committees receiving and expending \$1,000 or less~~
6 ~~[during the] in an election period. (a) Any provision of law~~
7 to the contrary notwithstanding, a candidate committee or
8 noncandidate committee whose aggregate contributions and
9 aggregate expenditures for the election period total \$1,000 or
10 less, shall electronically file only a final election period
11 report, and need not file a preliminary and final primary
12 report, a preliminary and final general report, or a special
13 election report.

14 (b) By June 30 of an election year, a candidate committee
15 that does not intend to receive contributions, or make
16 expenditures, that aggregate more than \$1,000 in an election



1 period shall notify the commission of its intent in the
2 candidate committee's organizational report.

3 (c) By the fifth calendar day before the due date of the
4 preliminary primary report, a noncandidate committee that does
5 not intend to receive contributions, or make expenditures, that
6 aggregate more than \$1,000 in an election period shall notify
7 the commission of its intent in the noncandidate committee's
8 organizational report.

9 [~~(b)~~] (d) Until the candidate committee's or noncandidate
10 committee's registration is terminated as provided in section
11 11-326, supplemental reports and other reports required by this
12 part shall be filed."

13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.




