A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FORMS SUBMITTED TO THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 481R-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Before conducting business in this State or issuing
4 any warranty, a warrantor shall register with the commissioner,
5 on a form prescribed by the commissioner, and shall pay to the
6 commissioner a fee as provided under section 431:7-101. A
7 person who sells or solicits a vehicle protection product, but
8 who is not a warrantor, shall not be required to register with
9 the commissioner as a warrantor.

10 (b) Warrantor registration records shall be updated
11 annually and shall contain the following information:

12 (1) The address of the principal office of the warrantor;

13 (2) The name and address of the warrantor's agent for the
14 service of process in this State, if other than the
15 warrantor;

16 (3) The identities of the warrantor's executive officer or
17 officers directly responsible for the warrantor's
18 vehicle protection product business;

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- 1 (4) The name, address, and telephone number of any
2 administrators designated by the warrantor to be
3 responsible for the administration of vehicle
4 protection product warranties in this State; and
5 ~~[(5) A copy of each warranty form the warrantor proposes~~
6 ~~to use in this State; and~~
7 ~~-(6)]~~ (5) A statement that the warrantor is in compliance
8 with the financial security requirements of section
9 481R-5 and that details how the warrantor intends to
10 meet the requirements, and proof of compliance with
11 the requirements."

12 SECTION 2. Section 481X-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 " ~~[§]~~ **§481X-3** ~~[§]~~ **Registration.** (a) Before conducting
15 business in this State, a provider shall register with the
16 commissioner, on a form prescribed by the commissioner, and
17 shall pay to the commissioner a fee as provided under section
18 431:7-101.

19 (b) Provider registration shall be updated annually and
20 shall contain the following information:

- 21 (1) The address of the principal office of the provider;

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- 1 (2) The name and address of the provider's agent for the
2 service of process in this State, if other than the
3 provider;
- 4 (3) The identities of the provider's executive officer or
5 officers directly responsible for the provider's
6 service contract business;
- 7 (4) The name, address, and telephone number of any
8 administrators designated by the provider to be
9 responsible for the administration of service
10 contracts in this State; and
- 11 ~~[(5) A copy of each service contract form the provider
12 proposes to use in this State; and~~
- 13 ~~-(6)]~~ (5) A statement that the provider is in compliance
14 with the financial responsibility requirements of
15 section 481X-4 and that details how the provider
16 intends to meet the requirements, and proof of
17 compliance with the requirements."

18 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


