

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to abolish the
2 juvenile accountability block grant trust fund pursuant to the
3 recommendation by the auditor in auditor's report no. 18-11.

4 SECTION 2. The juvenile accountability block grant trust
5 fund administratively established in 2011 by the department of
6 defense is abolished, and any remaining unencumbered balances
7 shall be transferred to the general fund.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
