8 **PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

9 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
10 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
11 herein, are hereby appropriated or authorized, as the case may
12 be, from the means of financing specified to the expending
13 agencies designated for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1,
14 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures and the
15 number of positions in each fiscal year of the biennium shall
16 not exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
17 fiscal year, except as provided elsewhere in this Act or as
18 provided by general law.

2 fiscal year 2020-2021 shall be expended for an agricultural
3 commodities marketing specialist III.

4 SECTION 7. Provided that of the special fund appropriation
5 for measurement standards (AGR812), the sum of \$153,936 or so
6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
7 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
8 year 2020-2021 shall be expended for three (3.00) measurement
9 standards inspector V.

10 SECTION 8. Provided that of the special fund appropriation
11 for measurement standards (AGR812), the sum of \$77,256 or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
14 year 2020-2021 shall be expended for a measurement standards
15 program manager.

16 SECTION 9. Provided that of the general fund appropriation
17 for general administration (AGR192), the sum of \$94,932 or so
18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
19 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
20 year 2020-2021 shall be expended for an administrative services
21 officer.



1 SECTION 10. Provided that, notwithstanding any provision
2 contained in the General Appropriations Act of 2019 that
3 appropriates funds and establishes position ceilings, the
4 positions authorized in section 2 shall be in addition to the
5 positions authorized for that program under the General
6 Appropriations Act of 2019; provided further that any incumbent
7 employee shall retain the employee's:

8 (1) Civil service status, whether permanent or temporary;
9 and

10 (2) Salary, seniority (except as may be prescribed by
11 applicable collective bargaining agreement), retention
12 points, prior service credit, any vacation and sick
13 leave credits previously earned, and other rights,
14 benefits, and privileges, in accordance with state
15 personnel laws.

16 SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,
17 provided that the funds appropriated in this Act may be
18 transferred with the approval of the governor to the General
19 Appropriations Act of 2019 (House Bill No. 2, H.D. 1, S.D. 1,
20 C.D.1), for program execution and expenditure.

21 SECTION 12. If any portion of this Act or its application
22 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for



1 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of
2 the Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be
3 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
4 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
5 be expended to fulfill the objective of such appropriation to
6 the extent possible.

7 SECTION 13. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
8 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may
9 correct the errors.

10 SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect on June 28, 2019.





