A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

4 The legislature finds that on March 11, 2019, a disturbance
5 in one of the Maui community correctional center living units
6 occurred. Inmates broke fire sprinklers, security control
7 glass, and cell window glass; started a fire; damaged cell doors
8 by destroying electronic locking mechanisms; ransacked cleaning
9 supplies; and destroyed tables, chairs, toilets, clothing
10 supplies, and linen supplies. Modules A, B, C, and D sustained
11 damage from the incident. To date, module B, which housed
12 ninety-four inmates, is not yet fully operational. The cost to
13 repair the extensive damage exceeds the funds available in the
14 department of public safety's budget. Thus, the department
15 requires an emergency appropriation to address the immediate
16 needs of Maui community correctional center.

17 The legislature further finds that the State needs an
18 emergency appropriation to house two hundred forty-eight inmates



1 for an additional six months at Saguaro Correctional Center in
2 Arizona because Halawa correctional facility is undergoing
3 security systems upgrades. The emergency appropriation will
4 also provide for costs to return the inmates to Hawaii.

5 The purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
6 appropriation for:

7 (1) The immediate needs of Maui community correctional
8 center; and

9 (2) Six months of housing costs for two hundred forty-
10 eight inmates at Saguaro Correctional Center in
11 Arizona and for costs to return the inmates to Hawaii.

12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,102,000 or so much
14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the
15 immediate needs of Maui community correctional center, including
16 temporary replacement of windows, a consultant fee for the
17 assessment of damages, replacement of numerous security doors,
18 electrical and mechanical repairs, and replacement of detention
19 grade glass for the control station and cell windows.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
21 public safety for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for six
4 months of housing costs for two hundred forty-eight inmates at
5 Saguaro Correctional Center in Arizona and for costs to return
6 the inmates to Hawaii.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
8 public safety for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 4. All procurements associated with funds
10 appropriated pursuant to section 2 of this Act shall be exempt
11 from chapters 103D and 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.




