A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISASTER RELIEF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 12, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, is amended
2 by amending sections 5 and 6 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 5. (a) There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000,000 or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 to
6 protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people, and
7 provide relief from disaster damages, losses, and suffering
8 caused by the extraordinary weather event that produced
9 torrential rains and resultant flooding in the county of Kauai
10 in April 2018[-] or to implement mitigation measures to prevent
11 and minimize the impacts of current or future flooding in areas
12 affected by the April 2018 flooding on Kauai.

13 The sum appropriated shall be allotted to the department of
14 defense and expended by the adjutant general solely for the
15 express stated purposes of this part; provided that the moneys
16 appropriated pursuant to this section shall not lapse at the end
17 of the fiscal year for which the moneys have been appropriated;



1 provided further that any moneys appropriated pursuant to this
2 section that are unencumbered as of June 30, [~~2019~~] 2020, shall
3 lapse on that date[-]; provided further that the moneys
4 appropriated pursuant to this section shall be exempt from
5 section 37-74(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

6 (b) As used in this section, "mitigation measures" means
7 the reduction of harm from future flooding events through
8 structural and nonstructural actions, interventions, and
9 investments.

10 SECTION 6. (a) There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$25,000,000 or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 to
13 protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people, and
14 provide relief from disaster damages, losses, and suffering
15 caused by the extraordinary weather event that produced
16 torrential rains and resultant flooding in areas of the State,
17 other than the county of Kauai, in April 2018[-] or to implement
18 mitigation measures to prevent and minimize the impacts of
19 current or future natural or man-made events in areas of the
20 State, other than the county of Kauai, affected by the April
21 2018 flooding.



1 The sum appropriated shall be allotted to the department of
2 defense and expended by the adjutant general solely for the
3 express stated purposes of this part; provided that the moneys
4 appropriated pursuant to this section shall not lapse at the end
5 of the fiscal year for which the moneys have been appropriated;
6 provided further that any moneys appropriated pursuant to this
7 section that are unencumbered as of June 30, [~~2019~~] 2020, shall
8 lapse on that date[-]; provided further that the moneys
9 appropriated pursuant to this section shall be exempt from
10 section 37-74(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

11 (b) As used in this section, "mitigation measures" means
12 the reduction of harm from future flooding events through
13 structural and nonstructural actions, interventions, and
14 improvements."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.




