A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 **PART I**

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated from the sources of
3 funding indicated below to health premium payments (BUF 761) the
4 following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund
5 for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 the Hawaii employer-union health
6 benefits trust fund costs in the agreement negotiated with the
7 exclusive representative of collective bargaining units (2),
8 (3), (4), (6), (8), (9), (13), and (14):

10 General funds	\$4,333,324	\$17,877,691

11 SECTION 2. Funds appropriated by this part shall be
12 allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state
13 departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for
14 the purposes of this part.

16 SECTION 3. There are appropriated from the sources of
17 funding indicated below to health premium payments (BUF 761) the
18 following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund



1 for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 the Hawaii employer-union health
2 benefits trust fund costs authorized by chapter 89C, Hawaii
3 Revised Statutes, for state officers and employees who are
4 excluded from collective bargaining and belong to the same
5 compensation plans as those officers and employees within
6 collective bargaining units (2), (3), (4), (6), (8), (9), (13),
7 and (14):

10 SECTION 4. Funds appropriated by this part shall be
11 allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state
12 departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for
13 the purposes of this part.

14 PART III

15 SECTION 5. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
16 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
17 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
18 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
19 from the respective funds.



1 SECTION 6. Funds appropriated by this Act that are not
2 expended or encumbered by June 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, of
3 the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of those dates.

4 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
