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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the  
3 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining  
4 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may  
5 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 all  
6 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated  
7 with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining unit  
8 (5):

9 General funds	\$13,847,977	\$16,477,943
10 Federal funds	\$332,395	\$381,695
11 Other federal funds	\$3,815	\$4,554

14 SECTION 2. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part  
15 shall be allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate  
16 state departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year  
17 for the purposes of this part.

8 are excluded from collective bargaining and belong to the same  
9 compensation plans as those officers and employees within  
10 bargaining unit (5):

6 exclusive representative of collective bargaining unit (5):

19 Revised Statutes, for state officers and employees who are  
20 excluded from collective bargaining and belong to the same

2 collective bargaining unit (5):

5 SECTION 8. Funds appropriated by this part shall be  
6 allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state  
7 departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for  
8 the purposes of this part.

9 PART V

10 SECTION 9. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided  
11 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is  
12 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds  
13 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,  
14 from the respective funds.

15 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act  
16 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2020, and  
17 June 30, 2021, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of  
18 those dates.

19 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
