A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 **PART I**

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the
3 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining
4 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 all
6 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated
7 with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining unit
8 (11):

10 General funds	\$212,910	\$429,024
11 Special funds	\$971,154	\$1,793,201

12 SECTION 2. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part
13 shall be allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate
14 state departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year
15 for the purposes of this part.

17 SECTION 3. There are appropriated or authorized from the
18 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining

14 benefits trust fund costs authorized by chapter 89C, Hawaii
15 Revised Statutes, for state officers and employees who are
16 excluded from collective bargaining and belong to the same
17 compensation plans as those officers and employees within
18 collective bargaining unit (11):

1 SECTION 8. Funds appropriated by this part shall be
2 allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state
3 departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for

6 SECTION 9. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
7 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
8 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
9 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
10 from the respective funds.

11 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
12 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2020, and
13 June 30, 2021, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
14 those dates.

15 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.


