STATEMENT OF OBJECTIONS TO SENATE BILL NO. 1530

Honorable Members  
Thirtieth Legislature  
State of Hawai'i

Pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, I am returning herewith, without my approval, Senate Bill No. 1530, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to the Hawaii Community Development Authority."

The purpose of this bill is to make the conversion of the means of financing for the Hawai'i Community Development Authority (HCDA) staff from the HCDA revolving fund to the general fund contingent on the HCDA developing a plan to transfer control of the Kaka'ako Community Development District to the City and County of Honolulu. The plan and proposed legislation to effectuate the transfer of control of the Kaka'ako Community Development District must be submitted to the Legislature prior to the convening of the 2020 regular session. The transfer must be executed by December 31, 2023.

This bill is objectionable because the short timeline to complete the required work to meet the conversion requirements could potentially threaten funding for thirteen HCDA positions in the third quarter of the upcoming fiscal year. Notwithstanding this objection, HCDA is committed to developing a comprehensive transition plan to transfer control of the Kaka'ako Community Development District to the City and County of Honolulu and to submitting proposed enabling legislation for the 2020 regular legislative session.

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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Provided that of the funds appropriated for  
2 BED150 during the 2019 regular session, the conversion of the  
3 means of financing for the Hawaii community development  
4 authority staff from the Hawaii community development revolving  
5 fund established pursuant to section 206E-16, Hawaii Revised  
6 Statutes, to the general fund may be executed if the:

7           (1) Hawaii community development authority develops a  
8           comprehensive transition plan to transfer the control  
9           of the authority's Kakaako community development  
10          district described in section 206E-32, Hawaii Revised  
11          Statutes, to the city and county of Honolulu;

12          (2) Comprehensive transition plan includes proposed  
13          enabling legislation to abolish the Hawaii community  
14          development authority's authority over the Kakaako  
15          community development district described in section  
16          206E-32, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and execute the  
17          transfer of control of the Kakaako community



1 development district to the city and county of  
2 Honolulu by no later than December 31, 2023; and  
3 (3) Plan and proposed legislation are submitted to the  
4 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the  
5 convening of the regular session of 2020.

6 If the Hawaii community development authority meets the  
7 requirements of paragraphs (1) to (3), then the conversion of  
8 the means of financing for the employment costs associated with  
9 the Hawaii community development authority staff from the Hawaii  
10 community development revolving fund established pursuant to  
11 section 206E-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the general fund  
12 shall commence from the beginning of the ensuing fiscal quarter  
13 immediately succeeding the Hawaii community development  
14 authority meeting all the requirements of paragraphs (1) to (3).

15 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


