4 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent
5 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a
6 particular program during a specified period or periods, as
7 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent
8 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent
9 positions.

10 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific
11 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization
12 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the
13 organization number for the program.

14 **PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

15 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much
16 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and
17 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or
18 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing
19 specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal
20 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The
21 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal

1 year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position
2 ceilings indicated for each fiscal year, except as provided
3 elsewhere in this part or as provided by general law.

1 **PART III. MISCELLANEOUS AND EFFECTIVE DATE**

2 SECTION 4. If any portion of parts 1, 2, and 3 sections 4
3 and 5 or its application to any person, entity, or circumstance
4 is held to be invalid for any reason, then the legislature
5 declares that the remainder of the Act and each and every other
6 provision thereof shall not be affected thereby. If any portion
7 of a specific appropriation is held to be invalid for any
8 reason, the remaining portion shall be expended to fulfill the
9 objective of the appropriation to the extent possible.

10 SECTION 5. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
11 mechanical errors are found in parts 1, 2, and 3 sections 4 and
12 5, the governor may correct the errors.

13 SECTION 6. The auditor shall conduct a performance audit
14 of the agribusiness development corporation, established
15 pursuant to chapter 163D, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The auditor
16 may conduct a financial audit if sufficient funds are available.
17 The auditor shall submit a report to the legislature of its
18 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
19 legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
20 the regular session of 2021.



PART IV. STATUTORY PROVISIONS

SECTION 7. "[+]§163D-19[+] **Annual report.** (a) The

corporation shall submit to the governor and the legislature, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session, a complete and detailed report of its plans and activities.

(b) The following information shall be included in the annual report and shall be posted on the corporation's website:

(1) The number of lots the corporation leased or used by size and by island;

(2) The number of lots by island the corporation leased or used that contain protocols and conditions supporting specialty farm products;

(3) The number of vacant parcels and unoccupied parcels in the leasing process by island, including the parcel size, location, and date the parcel was last occupied by a tenant; and

(4) A description of any lease sales or transfers approved by the corporation, including:

(A) A description of the type of farm products

produced by the transferring lessee and the farm
