
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SALARY OF THE STATE LIBRARIAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that existing law
2 authorizes the board of education to set the salary of the state
3 librarian as long as the salary does not exceed a specific
4 amount, also referred to as a salary cap. The state librarian's
5 current salary cap is \$120,000 per year, which was last updated
6 in 2001.

7 The purpose of this Act is to update the state librarian's
8 salary cap.

9 SECTION 2. Section 312-2.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

11 "(b) The salary of the state librarian shall be set by the
12 board of education at a rate no greater than [~~\$120,000~~] \$175,000
13 a year."

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
