SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING AN AUDIT OF DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PUBLIC WORKS
PROJECTS AT THE DANIEL K. INOUE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

1 WHEREAS, regular users of the Daniel K. Inouye
2 International Airport are frustrated with the airport due to its
3 inefficient design and a lack of space during peak hours; and
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5 WHEREAS, since the airport first opened in 1962, there have
6 been several completed expansions, but the last major project,
7 the current Terminal 1 (formerly the Interisland Terminal) was
8 opened twenty-five years ago; and
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10 WHEREAS, a long-awaited modernization project is underway
11 and plans are being developed for another concourse; and
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13 WHEREAS, the reportedly slow progress of construction
14 projects at the airport is at least partly attributable to
15 having the airport operated by a division of the executive
16 administration rather than by a public corporation; now,


19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
20 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2019, that the
21 Auditor is requested to conduct an audit of all public works
22 projects at the Daniel K. Inouye International Airport for which
23 the Department of Transportation was the government contracting
24 agency; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to
27 submit a report of the Auditor's findings and recommendations,
28 including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later
29 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session
30 of 2020; and
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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
2 Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor, Director of
3 Transportation, and Deputy Director - Airports.
