<u>SB 1006</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Includes certain spirits-based beverages in the definition of cooler beverage. Repeals definition of draft beer. Applies the same tax rate to all beer.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 1460</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Requires carriers to report shipments of liquor to county liquor commissions.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 638</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO LIQUOR. Adds unlicensed sale of liquor as an offense for which property is subject to forfeiture and increases the grade of the offense to a class C felony. Provides an affirmative defense. Amends definitions of "organized crime" and "racketeering activity" to include the unlicensed sale of liquor.	CPH, JDC
<u>SB 883</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Appropriates funds for healthy start child abuse prevention services.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 1024</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE AGING AND DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER. Appropriates funds to the department of health for the aging and disability resource center.	CPH, WAM
