<u>HB 888, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR816)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE MAUI HEALTH SYSTEM. Makes appropriations for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 to support the operations of the Maui Health System. (HB888 HD1)	CPH, WAM
<u>HB 1009, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1116)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO MOVIE THEATERS. Requires a movie theater to provide at least two showings per week per movie offered with open movie captioning. Removes the option of a movie theater to provide eyewear to fulfill the movie captioning requirement. Makes the requirement permanent by repealing the sunset date from Act 39, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015. (HB1009 HD1)	CPH, JDC
<u>HB 290, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR942)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT. Updates the Uniform Controlled Substances Act to make it consistent with amendments in federal controlled substances law as required under the authority to schedule controlled substances. (HB290 HD1)	CPH, JDC
<u>HB 1453, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1071)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES. Authorizes the Department of Health to establish fees for transportation to medical facilities and for provision of emergency medical services that do not include transport. Authorizes transportation by ambulance to medical facilities other than hospital emergency departments. (HB1453 HD1)	CPH, WAM
<u>HB 760, HD2</u> <u>(HSCR1194)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION. Requires full-service franchise restaurants to disclose their non-participation in national advertising campaigns that offer a promotion or discount with a sign at the entrance or storefront. (HB760 HD2)	CPH
<u>HB 764</u> <u>(HSCR879)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE. Clarifies that the requirement for a motor vehicle insurer to maintain a complete sales and claims service office does not apply to the county of Kalawao.	CPH
