# RELATING TO HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS WITH SEVERE

HSH/HLT, JUD, FIN

MENTAL ILLNESS.

Requires the department of human services to establish a task force to determine specific implementation requirements necessary to establish a pilot program to provide shelter and mental health treatment for homeless individuals with severe mental illness or severe co-occurring mental illness and substance use disorders who are subject to courtordered guardianship. Appropriates funds. (SD1)
