<u>HB 751</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE PEER REVIEW OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE. Clarifies that a member may qualify for the peer review oversight committee so long as the member does not have a fail rating.	IAC, CPC
<u>HB 63</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO REAL ESTATE LICENSES. Requires a high school education or its equivalent as a condition for obtaining a license as a real estate broker or real estate salesperson.	IAC, CPC
<u>HB 270</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO REBUILT VEHICLES. Includes flood damage and material damage to a motor vehicle's electronics in the definition of "rebuilt vehicle" in section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes.	IAC, CPC
<u>HB 533, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR170)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO BROADBAND. Establishes the Hawaii Broadband Office within DBEDT. Establishes the position of State Broadband Strategy Officer. Requires the Director of DBEDT to convene and chair the Broadband Assistance Advisory Council. Appropriates funds. (HB533 HD1)	EDB, IAC, FIN
<u>HB 1163</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SAVINGS PROMOTION CONTESTS. Authorizes financial institutions that are depository institutions to conduct savings promotion contests in which its account holders are contestants.	IAC, FIN
