<u>HB 415</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TUITION AND FEES SPECIAL FUND. Repeals the requirement that each UH campus prepare an operations plan for each fiscal year. Repeals the automatic lapse of moneys in the UH Tuition and Fees Special Fund.	LHE, FIN
<u>HB 813</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROMISE PROGRAM PLUS. Establishes the University of Hawaii Promise Program Plus to provide scholarships for the unmet direct cost needs of qualified students enrolled in a bachelor's degree at the University of Hawaii who are (1) graduates of a University of Hawaii community college who received a Hawaii community college promise program scholarship; and (2) enrolled at any University of Hawaii campus. Appropriates funds to establish and implement the program.	LHE, FIN
<u>HB 1277</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROMISE PROGRAM. Provides scholarships for the unmet direct cost needs of qualified students at any four-year University of Hawaii campus who meet certain eligibility criteria.	LHE, FIN
<u>HB 1469</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE COLLEGE SAVINGS PROGRAM. Establishes a state income tax deduction for eligible contributions made to the Hawaii college savings program.	LHE, FIN
<u>HB 1102</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE EDUCATION. Establishes and appropriates funds for the P-20 agriculture education coordinator position within the University of Hawaii at Manoa college of tropical agriculture and human resources. Specifies duties of the coordinator and P-20 agriculture education working group.	LHE, AGR, FIN

LHE, FIN

Requires the University of Hawaii system to create additional distance-learning classes in teaching for students who are pursuing undergraduate degrees in education.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
