<u>HB 893</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS BUDGET. Appropriates funds for the fiscal biennium 2019-2021 operating budget of the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands programs under the purview of the House of Representatives Standing Committee on Water, Land, and Hawaiian Affairs.	WLH, FIN
<u>HB 172</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS. Appropriates funds for Fiscal Biennium 2019-2021 for operations of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs divisions. Includes operating budgets for Office of Trustees – OHA150; Administration – OHA160; and Beneficiary Advocacy – OHA175.	WLH, FIN
<u>HB 1094</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE AHA MOKU ADVISORY COMMITTEE. Appropriates funds to the Department of Land and Natural Resources for the operations of the Aha Moku Advisory Committee. Appropriates funds to hire an expert on natural and physical environment to serve in a full-time equivalent position on the committee.	WLH, FIN
<u>HB 1406</u> <u>Status</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR IOLANI PALACE. Appropriates funds for Iolani Palace's maintenance and operating costs.	WLH, FIN
<u>HB 1219</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS. Authorizes the designation of areas or regions of public lands classified as commercial, industrial, resort and hotel, and the establishment and implementation of guidelines for the redevelopment of the areas or regions that will: (1) modernize the policies for the management of public lands in the designated area; (2) establish a plan for the designated area, including district-wide improvements, that is coordinated with state and county land use and planning policies; and (3) implement asset and property management concepts that can optimize income from the properties and evolve in response to changing principles of property administration. Designates the public lands on the Waiakea peninsula on the island of Hawaii as the Waiakea Peninsula Redevelopment District. Repeals the Waiakea Peninsula Redevelopment District on 6/30/2029. Appropriates funds.	WLH, FIN


As this is a decision making meeting only, no public testimony will be accepted.
