
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public lands hold
2 significant value to the State's economy, open spaces, and
3 wildlife. The legislature further finds that public lands also
4 benefit the State's residents and visitors through the provision
5 of recreational opportunities and provide mineral, grazing, and
6 forestry resources.

7 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish the
8 fourth Saturday in September of each year as public lands day to
9 promote awareness of the significant value and beneficial
10 impacts of the State's public lands.

11 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
12 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
13 read as follows:

14 "§8- Public Lands Day. The fourth Saturday in
15 September of each year shall be known and designated as "Public
16 Lands Day"; provided that this day is not and shall not be
17 construed to be a state holiday."



1 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2051.
