# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO UPDATE THE LEGISLATURE ON  
THE STATUS OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE STAN SHERIFF CENTER SOUND  
SYSTEM.

1           WHEREAS, the Stan Sheriff Center is a 10,300-seat  
2 multi-purpose arena on the campus of the University of Hawaii at  
3 Manoa and home to the University of Hawaii men's Rainbow  
4 Warriors basketball and volleyball, and women's Rainbow Wahine  
5 basketball and volleyball teams; and

7           WHEREAS, the existing Stan Sheriff Center sound system  
8 sounds distorted and is not operating properly; and

9  
10           WHEREAS, the Legislature has provided funding to the  
11 University of Hawaii for the repair of the sound system the past  
12 two years, yet no improvements appear to have been made; and

14           WHEREAS, during a recent meeting between the Chair of the  
15 Senate Standing Committee on Higher Education and the University  
16 of Hawaii Athletics Director, issues with the sound system were  
17 recognized and it was acknowledged that the University of Hawaii  
18 is working on the problem; now, therefore,

20           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature  
21 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of  
22 Representatives concurring, that the University of Hawaii is  
23 requested to provide the Legislature with an update on repairs  
24 and improvements to the Stan Sheriff Center sound system; and

26           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
27 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
