begs leave to report as follows:


The purpose of this measure is to establish and appropriate funds for a two-year autonomous vehicle testing pilot program within the Department of Transportation.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Transportation, State Council on Developmental Disabilities, Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Commission, City and County of Honolulu Department of Transportation Services, Ulupono Initiative, Hawaii Automobile Dealers' Association, Pele Lani Farm LLC, and one individual. 
