
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DOMESTIC ABUSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 431:10-217.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
2 is amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 3 "(e) As used in this section, "domestic abuse" means:
- 4 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the
5 infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily
6 injury, or assault between family or household
7 members;
- 8 (2) Sexual assault of one family or household member by
9 another;
- 10 (3) Stalking of one family or household member by another
11 family or household member; [~~or~~]
- 12 (4) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing damage
13 to property so as to intimidate or attempt to control
14 the behavior of another household member[-]; or
- 15 (5) Coercive control, as defined in section 586-1, between
16 family or household members."



1 SECTION 2. Section 432:1-101.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
2 is amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

3 "(e) As used in this section, "domestic abuse" means:

- 4 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the
5 infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily
6 injury, or assault between family or household
7 members;
- 8 (2) Sexual assault of one family or household member by
9 another;
- 10 (3) Stalking of one family or household member by another
11 family or household member; [~~or~~]
- 12 (4) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing damage
13 to property so as to intimidate or attempt to control
14 the behavior of another household member[-]; or
- 15 (5) Coercive control, as defined in section 586-1, between
16 family or household members."

17 SECTION 3. Section 432:2-103.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
18 is amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

19 "(e) As used in this section, "domestic abuse" means:

- 20 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the
21 infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily

- 3 (2) Sexual assault of one family or household member by

 13 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

- 16 infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily
- 17 injury, or assault between family or household
- 18 members;
- 19 (2) Sexual assault of one family or household member by

- 1 (3) Stalking of one family or household member by another
- 2 family or household member; [~~or~~]
- 3 (4) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing damage
- 4 to property so as to intimidate or attempt to control
- 5 the behavior of another household member [~~-~~]; or
- 6 (5) Coercive control, as defined in section 586-1, between
- 7 family or household members."

8 SECTION 5. Section 586-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 9 amended as follows:

10 1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
 11 and to read:

12 "Coercive control" means a pattern of threatening,
 13 humiliating, or intimidating actions, which may include
 14 assaults, or other abuse that is used to harm, punish, or
 15 frighten an individual. "Coercive control" includes a pattern
 16 of behavior that seeks to take away the individual's liberty or
 17 freedom and strip away the individual's sense of self, including
 18 bodily integrity and human rights, whereby the "coercive
 19 control" is designed to make an individual dependent by
 20 isolating them from support, exploiting them, depriving them of
 21 independence, and regulating their everyday behavior including:



- 1 (1) Isolating the individual from friends and family;
2 (2) Controlling how much money is accessible to the
3 individual and how it is spent;
4 (3) Monitoring the individual's activities,
5 communications, and movements;
6 (4) Name-calling, degradation, and demeaning the
7 individual frequently;
8 (5) Threatening to harm or kill the individual or a child
9 or relative of the individual;
10 (6) Threatening to publish information or make reports to
11 the police or the authorities;
12 (7) Damaging property or household goods; and
13 (8) Forcing the individual to take part in criminal
14 activity or child abuse."
- 15 2. By amending the definition of "domestic abuse" to read:
16 "Domestic abuse" means:
17 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the threat
18 of imminent physical harm, bodily injury, or assault,
19 extreme psychological abuse, coercive control, or
20 malicious property damage between family or household
21 members; or



1 (2) Any act which would constitute an offense under
2 section 709-906, or under part V or VI of chapter 707
3 committed against a minor family or household member
4 by an adult family or household member."

5 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
