## HOUSE RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING THE SAINT LOUIS CRUSADERS ON WINNING THE 2019  
DIVISION I-OPEN FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP.

1           WHEREAS, founded in 1846, Saint Louis School is Hawaii's  
2 premier all-boys school, offering a college-preparatory program  
3 that includes award-winning programs in Language Arts,  
4 Mathematics, Science and Technology, Hawaiian Studies, Robotics  
5 and Engineering, Business Leadership, Athletics, and Performing  
6 Arts; and

8           WHEREAS, located in Honolulu on the island of Oahu, Saint  
9 Louis School offers a quality education open to students of all  
10 faiths, putting emphasis on spiritual, emotional, and  
11 intellectual growth under the Catholic Marianist tradition of  
12 education; students benefit from a curriculum that has developed  
13 countless successful professional leaders; and

15           WHEREAS, the SAINT LOUIS CRUSADERS represent a proud  
16 tradition with a storied history, encouraging all student-  
17 athletes to embrace the school's emphasis on striving for  
18 excellence and exhibiting good sportsmanship and fair play; and

20           WHEREAS, the SAINT LOUIS CRUSADERS believe that athletics  
21 is an important aspect of education and that it is important to  
22 help young men develop into responsible adults, building on and  
23 using the insights of Father William Joseph Chaminade to foster  
24 an atmosphere that challenges each young man to move beyond what  
25 he might perceive as obstacles to realize his full potential;

28           WHEREAS, in November of 2019, the SAINT LOUIS CRUSADERS won  
29 the Division I-Open football championship title for the fourth  
30 straight year when the team defeated Kahuku High School, 45-6,  
31 in the state championship game at Aloha Stadium; the Crusaders  
32 ended the 2019 prep football season ranked No. 9 in the country,



1 with eight players signing letters of intent with Division I  
2 colleges on the first day of the early signing period; and

4 WHEREAS, three different quarterbacks have guided the SAINT  
5 LOUIS CRUSADERS to the state championships: most recently,  
6 Jayden deLaura, who will be attending Washington State  
7 University next fall; Chevan Cordeiro, now at the University of  
8 Hawaii, in 2017; and in 2016, Tua Tagovailoa, who recently  
9 declared his intent to enter into the NFL Draft; now, therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
12 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of  
13 2020, that this body hereby congratulates the SAINT LOUIS  
14 CRUSADERS on winning the 2019 Division I-Open football  
15 championship, applauds the team and the athletic program for  
16 their commitment to excellence and for providing life lessons  
17 outside of the classroom, and extends to them its best wishes  
18 for continued success in all future endeavors.
