A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXECUTIVE BRANCH POSITIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-34.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) There is established the state capitol management
4 committee, which shall be composed of the following members or
5 their respective designees:

6 (1) The [~~governor's chief of staff;~~] administrative
7 director of the State;

8 (2) The comptroller;

9 (3) The director of public safety;

10 (4) Two members of the senate as appointed by the
11 president of the senate;

12 (5) Two members of the house of representatives as
13 appointed by the speaker of the house of
14 representatives;

15 (6) A legislative officer of the senate appointed by the
16 president of the senate; and



1 (7) A legislative officer of the house of representatives
2 appointed by the speaker of the house of
3 representatives;

4 provided that for members appointed pursuant to paragraphs (6)
5 and (7), "legislative officer" shall have the same meaning as
6 that term is defined in section 88-21.

7 The chairperson of the state capitol management committee
8 shall be elected by the committee members. The department of
9 accounting and general services shall provide administrative
10 support to the state capitol management committee; provided that
11 the committee shall also receive fiscal analysis support from
12 the department of budget and finance as the committee deems
13 appropriate."

14 SECTION 2. Section 226-64, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

16 "(a) The Hawaii interagency council for transit-oriented
17 development shall be composed of the following members:

18 (1) Director of the office of planning, who shall serve as
19 co-chair;

20 (2) Executive director of the Hawaii housing finance and
21 development corporation, who shall serve as co-chair;

- 3 (4) Chairperson of the board of land and natural
- 4 resources;
- 5 (5) Director of transportation;
- 6 (6) Comptroller;
- 7 (7) Director of health;
- 8 (8) Director of human services;
- 9 (9) Director of public safety;
- 10 (10) Chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission;
- 11 (11) Chairperson of the stadium authority;
- 12 (12) President of the University of Hawaii;
- 13 (13) Superintendent of education;
- 14 (14) Executive director of the Hawaii community development
- 15 authority;
- 16 (15) Executive director of the Hawaii public housing
- 17 authority;
- 18 (16) One member of the house of representatives to be
- 19 designated by the speaker of the house of
- 20 representatives; provided that the speaker of the
- 21 house of representatives may designate a second member



- 1 of the house of representatives to serve as an
2 alternate;
- 3 (17) One member of the senate to be designated by the
4 president of the senate; provided that the president
5 of the senate may designate a second member of the
6 senate to serve as an alternate;
- 7 (18) The mayor of each county;
- 8 (19) A representative of the Honolulu field office of the
9 United States Department of Housing and Urban
10 Development, who shall be requested to serve on a
11 nonvoting[+], [+] ex officio basis by the governor;
- 12 (20) A representative of the business community, to be
13 designated by the governor;
- 14 (21) A representative of the community who is a housing
15 advocate, to be designated by the governor; and
- 16 (22) A representative of the community with experience in
17 housing and real estate development, to be designated
18 by the governor."



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1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
