
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The university of Hawaii shall collaborate
2 with the department of education; the department of business,
3 economic development, and tourism; other public agencies;
4 private businesses; and foundations to further develop
5 interactive web tools that will enable degree-seeking
6 individuals to make better-informed decisions regarding their
7 post-secondary education and career choices by providing:

8 (1) Access to data that:

9 (A) Identifies in-demand jobs across the State and in
10 particular regions, as well as any degree or
11 certificate programs that will prepare students
12 for those jobs;

13 (B) Compares projected future earnings to the
14 investment required to graduate from a particular
15 school and program;

16 (C) Analyzes the earnings potential of various career
17 options; and



1 (D) Helps students understand the personal and
2 professional satisfaction that may accompany
3 various careers and courses of study;

4 (2) A lifestyle goal calculator that shows the number of
5 years it will take for the salary from a particular
6 occupation to meet an individual's lifestyle goals;
7 and

8 (3) A breakeven calculator that shows the number of years
9 it will take after completing a particular degree
10 program for earnings to exceed the total net price of
11 the program.

12 (b) In developing and implementing the interactive web
13 tool, the university of Hawaii may explore similar interactive
14 web tools in other jurisdictions and consult with these
15 jurisdictions or web tool developers.

16 (c) The university of Hawaii shall submit an annual report
17 to the legislature regarding its collaboration on the
18 utilization of interactive web tools to enable degree-seeking
19 individuals to make better-informed decisions regarding their
20 post-secondary education and career choices, including any

1 proposed legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the
2 convening of each regular session.

3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the
6 university of Hawaii, in collaboration with the department of
7 education and the department of business, economic development,
8 and tourism, and other entities, to utilize interactive web
9 tools to enable degree-seeking individuals to make better-
10 informed decisions regarding their post-secondary education and
11 career choices.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of
13 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
