A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-420, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~§302A-420~~ Profits to pupils. All net profits arising
4 from agricultural [~~and~~], industrial, or commercial enterprise
5 pursuits [~~under sections 302A-420 to 302A-431~~] at any school,
6 under the rules of the department:

7 (1) Shall be used by the school for the purchase of
8 equipment and material, not otherwise provided for in
9 the school budget, that will be of general benefit to
10 the pupils; or

11 (2) May be distributed among the pupils actually engaged
12 in the pursuits.

13 The department shall provide for the keeping of simple books of
14 account, showing the source and distribution of the money
15 resulting from the operations carried on pursuant to this
16 section, and for the auditing of these books of account at least
17 quarterly."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
