
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-420, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§302A-420 Profits to ~~[pupils-]~~ and school credit for
4 students. All net profits arising from agricultural [~~and]~~,
5 industrial, or commercial enterprise pursuits [~~under sections~~
6 ~~302A-420 to 302A-431]~~ at any school, under the rules of the
7 department:

8 (1) Shall be used by the school for the purchase of
9 equipment and material, not otherwise provided for in
10 the school budget, that will be of general benefit to
11 the pupils; or

12 (2) May be distributed among the [~~pupils]~~ students
13 actually engaged in the pursuits[~~-~~]; provided that
14 school credit may also be granted to students engaged
15 in the permitted operations.

16 The department shall provide for the keeping of simple books of
17 account, showing the source and distribution of the money



1 resulting from the operations carried on pursuant to this
2 section, and for the auditing of these books of account at least
3 quarterly."

4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
