SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE RECESS OF THE THIRTIETH LEGISLATURE, REGULAR
SESSION OF 2020.

1 WHEREAS, House Concurrent Resolution No. 1, Regular Session
2 of 2020, provided designated recess days for the Regular Session
3 of 2020 and was previously adopted by the House of
4 Representatives and the Senate; and
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6 WHEREAS, the Governor's Eighth Supplementary Proclamation
7 Related to the COVID-19 Emergency, issued May 18, 2020,
8 recognizes that the virus continues to endanger the health,
9 safety, and welfare of the people of Hawai'i; keeps in place the
10 social distancing requirements described and recommended by the
11 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention that restrict the
12 gathering of fifty or more people; and encourages social
13 distancing to minimize the transmission of infectious disease
14 between people; and
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16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 242,
17 Regular Session of 2020, the Legislature recessed the Regular
18 Session of 2020 on March 17, 2020, and thereafter reconvened on
19 May 11, 2020; and
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21 WHEREAS, pursuant to Article III, section 10, of the Hawaii
22 State Constitution, any session may be recessed by concurrent
23 resolution adopted by a majority of the members of each chamber;
24 now, therefore,
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26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
27 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of
28 Representatives concurring, that the Regular Session of 2020 be
29 recessed for at least three days, beginning May 22, 2020; and
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31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at the appropriate time the
32 Senate President and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

2 reconvene the Regular Session of 2020; and

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4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
5 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor.
