Status

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT. LHE, FIN
Requires a public school that has a career and technical education requirement relating to health care workforce development to review all geographic exception applications and make a determination whether to allow students to enroll in career and technical education programs in schools outside the Department of Education service area in which the student resides.

Status

RELATING TO EDUCATION. LHE, FIN
Establishes a no-time to lose commission to examine how the State's public schools can be internationally competitive. Appropriates funds.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


