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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to abolish or  
2 reclassify various non-general funds pursuant to the  
3 recommendations by the auditor in auditor's report no. 20-18 and  
4 to transfer the unencumbered balances to other appropriate non-  
5 general funds.

6           SECTION 2. The commissioner's education and training fund  
7 established pursuant to the authority granted by section  
8 431:2-214, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is reclassified as a special  
9 fund.

10          SECTION 3. The compliance resolution fund--appraisal  
11 management registration program special fund administratively  
12 established in 2017 is abolished and any remaining unencumbered  
13 balance shall lapse to the credit of the compliance resolution  
14 fund established pursuant to section 26-9(o), Hawaii Revised  
15 Statutes.

16          SECTION 4. The electrical vehicle charging system rebate  
17 program special fund administratively established in 2019 is


1 abolished and any remaining unencumbered balance shall lapse to
