# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The candidate, authorized person in the case of a  
4 noncandidate committee that is a party, or treasurer in the case  
5 of a candidate committee or other noncandidate committee, that,  
6 within the period of fourteen calendar days through four  
7 calendar days prior to any election~~[7]~~ for which the candidate  
8 is on the ballot, makes contributions aggregating more than  
9 \$500, or receives contributions from any person aggregating more  
10 than \$500, shall file a late contribution report by means of the  
11 commission's electronic filing system on or before the third  
12 calendar day prior to the election~~[7]~~ for which the candidate is  
13 on the ballot."

14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.

**Report Title:**

Elections; Contributions; Candidate Reporting Requirement; Late Contribution Report

**Description:**

Clarifies that the requirement to file a late contribution report after an election for candidates or certain other committee representatives who make or receive contributions over a certain amount applies only if the candidate is on the ballot in that election. Effective 7/1/2112. (HD1)
