
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) The candidate, authorized person in the case of a
4 noncandidate committee that is a party, or treasurer in the case
5 of a candidate committee or other noncandidate committee, that,
6 within the period of fourteen calendar days through four
7 calendar days [~~prior to~~] before any election, makes
8 contributions aggregating more than [~~\$500,~~] \$ _____, or
9 receives contributions from any person aggregating more than
10 [~~\$500,~~] \$ _____, shall file a late contribution report by
11 means of the commission's electronic filing system on or before
12 the third calendar day [~~prior to~~] before the election[~~-~~];
13 provided that this late contribution report does not need to be
14 filed by a candidate or the treasurer of a candidate committee
15 if the candidate is not on the election ballot."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
