No. 11 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND  
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO SUPPORT AND IMPLEMENT AFTERSCHOOL  
PROGRAMS TO COMBAT COVID-19 LEARNING LOSS,"

The purpose of this measure is to urge the Board of Education  
and Department of Education to support and implement afterschool  
programs as an equity strategy to combat COVID-19 learning loss.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from Hawai'i Children's Action Network Speaks!, Hui For Excellence  
in Education, and three individuals.

Your Committee finds that student learning has been  
significantly disrupted by the shift away from in-person learning  
due to school closures in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The  
shift away from in-person learning has disproportionately impacted  
disadvantaged students from low-income families. The afterschool  
programs urged by this measure will provide additional learning  
opportunities for those most in need.


