The purpose and intent of this measure is to urge the
Department of Defense to continue to operate the Hawaii National
Guard Youth Challenge Academy's Hilo Campus.

Your Committee received comments on this measure from the
Department of Defense.


Your Committee finds that the mission of the National Guard
youth challenge program is to intervene in and reclaim the lives
of sixteen to eighteen year old "at promise" youth and produce
program graduates with the values, life skills, education, and
self-discipline necessary to succeed as productive citizens. The
Hawaii National Guard Youth Challenge Academy's Hilo Campus has
been extremely successful in dissuading at-risk youths from
causing harm to others and themselves. Due to budget constraints,
the Hawaii Department of Defense is expected to close the Hawaii
National Guard Youth Challenge Academy's Hilo Campus and eliminate
forty-two positions. This measure will urge the Department of
Defense to continue to operate the Hawaii National Guard Youth
Challenge Academy's Hilo Campus so that it will not close and the



cadets may continue to receive the invaluable benefits associated with the Hilo campus.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental, and Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 73 and recommends its adoption.
