## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AHA MOKU ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1.   Section 171-4.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3           "(c)   The members shall not receive compensation for their  
4 service, but shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses,  
5 including travel expenses, incurred while participating in  
6 meetings and events approved in advance by the chairperson of  
7 the board of land and natural resources.

8           The ~~[aha moku advisory committee may hire]~~ governor shall  
9 appoint an executive director who shall be exempt from chapter  
10 76[-] and shall be subject to the advice and consent of the  
11 senate for a term of four years. The executive director may  
12 serve no longer than four consecutive years. The executive  
13 director may hire an administrative or executive assistant to  
14 assist the executive director in accomplishing the purposes of  
15 the aha moku advisory committee."

16           SECTION 2.   This Act applies to all hires or appointments  
17 commenced on or after the effective date of this section,


1 regardless of when the hire or appointment was made. To this  
2 extent, this Act applies retroactively, but in all other  
3 respects it applies prospectively.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
