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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AEROSPACE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 201-72.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 repealed.

3 [~~"§201-72.5 Aerospace advisory committee. (a) There is~~  
4 ~~established an aerospace advisory committee within the office of~~  
5 ~~aerospace development of the department of business, economic~~  
6 ~~development, and tourism for administrative purposes. The~~  
7 ~~committee shall be composed of thirteen members appointed by the~~  
8 ~~governor, as provided in section 26-34, except as otherwise~~  
9 ~~provided in this section. Of the thirteen members:~~

10 ~~(1) Three members shall be representatives of the~~  
11 ~~aerospace industry. One member shall be appointed~~
