## HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO ELIMINATE THE ONE HOUR GRACE PERIOD FOR ANY VEHICLE PARKING IN A RESIDENTIAL RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE WITHOUT A PLACARD.

1           WHEREAS, certain neighborhoods in the State are located in  
2 such a way that limits the number of available and convenient  
3 public parking spaces; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, to address this, in 2017 the City and County of  
6 Honolulu began a pilot program to establish residential  
7 restricted parking zones that limited parking on public streets  
8 to residents of that neighborhood; and  
9

10           WHEREAS, by most accounts, the pilot program was a success  
11 and led to the Honolulu City Council enacting Ordinance  
12 No. 17-45, to make the pilot program permanent; and  
13

14           WHEREAS, the residential restricted parking zone program  
15 improved the quality of life for residents in the surrounding  
16 neighborhood by making available multiple parking spaces closer  
17 to their residences; and

19           WHEREAS, currently, the ordinance allows up to one-hour of  
20 parking for any individual within the residential restricted  
21 parking zone, regardless of whether they have a permit; and  
22

23           WHEREAS, eliminating the one-hour grace period would  
24 further improve certain resident's quality of life; now,  
25 therefore

27           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
28 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
29 of 2021, that the City and County of Honolulu's Department of  
30 Transportation Services is urged to seek to amend the ordinance  
31 on the residential restricted parking zone in Kalihi, House



1 District 28, to eliminate the one hour grace period for any  
2 vehicle parking in an restricted parking zone and to ticket and  
3 tow any vehicle in violation of parking without an appropriate  
4 placard in the restricted parking zone; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
7 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the Department of  
8 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu and  
9 the State House of Representative of District 28.
