
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that while basic
2 department of Hawaiian home land applicant waiting lists are
3 available for download on the department's website, the exact
4 details of each applicant, including whether the person has
5 applied for multiple leases, been denied a prior lease, or been
6 skipped over, is not readily accessible, even for department
7 staff. Beneficiary records of the department of Hawaiian home
8 lands are spread across multiple locations. If a beneficiary
9 seeks to determine the beneficiary's status, finding and
10 gathering that information can take weeks. This lack of
11 organization has led to some lessees abusing the program by
12 selling or transferring their leases and reapplying for a
13 subsequent lease.

14 The legislature further finds that compiling applicant
15 information into a single database will help increase the
16 efficiency of the department of Hawaiian home lands and reduce
17 lease award abuse by lessees.



1 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
2 Hawaiian home lands to digitize its beneficiary waiting lists
3 and other related data.

4 SECTION 2. The department of Hawaiian home lands, with the
5 assistance of the office of enterprise technology services,
6 shall create a digital database of its applicant, beneficiary,
7 and lessee records. The database shall contain relevant
8 information on:

- 9 (1) Each individual's:
 - 10 (A) Homestead lease application status;
 - 11 (B) Number of applications submitted;
 - 12 (C) Address;
 - 13 (D) Number of denied leases;
 - 14 (E) Designated successors; and
 - 15 (F) History regarding whether the individual obtained
16 a lease as an applicant or as a successor; and
- 17 (2) Other information as determined by the Hawaiian homes
18 commission.

19 The digital database required by this Act shall be
20 completed and available for use by the department of Hawaiian
21 home lands no later than July 1, 2022.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
