A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$23,712,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 fourteenth senatorial district, as follows:

5 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
 6 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 7 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 8 provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
 9 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
 11 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
 12 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

- 13 (1) The sums appropriated in items (1) through (9) shall
 14 be expended by the department of education; and
- 15 (2) The sum appropriated in item (10) shall be expended by
 16 the department of land and natural resources.

17 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
