SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND
TOURISM AND DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES
TO CONDUCT A COST ANALYSIS STUDY OF CONSOLIDATING WEST
HAWAII STATE OFFICES INTO A SINGLE CONVENIENTLY LOCATED
COMPLEX.

1 WHEREAS, there are various state offices operating in
2 various locations in west Hawai'i island; and

4 WHEREAS, state offices not dependent on location can be
5 consolidated in one convenient area at a single location for
6 purposes of cost effectiveness and efficiency; and

8 WHEREAS, the consolidation of state services in a single
9 central location will improve services; now, therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first
12 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the
13 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
14 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism and Department of
15 Accounting and General Services are requested to conduct a cost
16 analysis study regarding centralizing and consolidating the
17 state offices in west Hawai'i island into one conveniently
18 located complex; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Business,
21 Economic Development, and Tourism and Department of Accounting
22 and General Services are requested to submit a report of their
23 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
24 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior
25 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2022; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Director
